### **Adjusting the Jogging Speed**



**Note:** When the screws are located opposite each other on the shaft, the minimum action is obtained. When the screws are located on the same side of the shaft, the maximum action is obtained. Normal action is obtained when the screws are 80° to 90° apart.

# **Trouble Shooting Guide**

Problem	Cause	Correction
Machine does not turn on.	Machine is not plugged in or there is no electricity to the outlet.	Make sure the power cord is connected correctly and that the outlet is live.
	Power switch is faulty.	Contact a service technician to replace the power switch.
	Motor has burned out.	Contact a service technician to replace the motor.
The motor turns on but the machine does not jog as desired.	The Torque Tube (L-1019) has worn out or broken.	Replace the Torque Tube.
	The screw on the Eccentric Adjustment Disc (L-1017) has come loose allowing the disc to shift.	Access the Adjustment Discs and tighten down the screw as shown on page 1.
