

FREQUENTLY ASK QUESTIONS

1. Can a worn cutting stick affect the cut quality of the bottom sheet you are cutting?

Yes, when this happens, the cut stick can be rotated.

2. Should I have more than one knife for my machine?

It is beneficial to purchase several knives for your machine. One in the machine, one as a back up, and one out for resharpening.

3. What are the parts of the knife?

Cutting edge is also called the front edge. The top edge of the knife is the spine. The back of the knife is called the face.

4. What does HC/HC mean?

High Carbon High Chrome. Used primarily for a 3 Knife Trimmer.

5. What is the difference between standard and metric holes?

Several machines use metric bolts instead of standard bolts. The difference is the number of threads per inch. We have noted in the catalog with an asterik if this information is necessary for the knife you are purchasing.

6. How to convert millimeters into inches?

Simply divide the millimeters by 25.4. Example: 508 mm is 20".

7. What is the average bevel on a knife? 22 - 24 degrees.

8. What information do you need to get a quote on a special cutting stick? We would need the exact measurements down to the millimeter. If you are unsure, please send us a sample of the stick and we will measure it on our end with a micrometer.
